

Instructions of technical arrangement of the paper

Paper submission	Papers are submitted exclusively by email to the address: naucniskup@vsob-gbr.edu.rs. The paper is submitted in the text processor Microsoft Word, page A4 format, font Times New Roman, font size: 12, spacing 1.5.
Language of paper	Papers are submitted in the Serbian language, in the Cyrillic alphabet.
Length of paper	Papers should be 6 to 8 pages long, including an abstract and references.
Paper writing Title page	<p>The title page of the text should contain the following information: name of the author (co-author), name of the institution, place, written in font size: 10; the title of the paper, written in capital letters, font size: 12, bold and centered. The title of the paper should be concise, but precisely formulated.</p> <p>The summary should contain up to 300 words, with keywords highlighted, from 3 to 5, font size: 11, spacing 1.5.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In the case of papers that are a presentation of the conducted research, the summary should contain: the significance of the research problem, research objectives, research methodology, key research results, conclusions and pedagogical implications. - In papers that represent theoretical analyses, the content of the summary should be adapted to the nature of the paper and the content of the text.
Pages of the paper	The pages of the work should be numbered in the lower right corner.
Paper structure	<p>Each paper should contain an introduction and a conclusion.</p> <p>In addition to the introduction and conclusion, the papers representing the research carried out should contain the following sections: initial theoretical foundations of the research, research methodology, results and discussion.</p> <p>The structure of review papers and papers representing theoretical analyses should be adapted to the title of the paper.</p> <p>Section titles should be formulated clearly and precisely, given centered and bold, font size: 11. If subtitles are used in the text of the section, they should be indicated in italics, indented in a paragraph, in "sentence" form. Section headings and sub-headings do not need to be numbered.</p>
References and literature	<p>References to sources in the text and the list of used literature at the end of the paper should be given in accordance with APA style (<i>APA Citation Style-American Psychological Association</i>). The current edition of the <i>Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA7)</i> can be found at the link: https://apastyle.apa.org/style-grammar-guidelines/references/examples</p> <p>Examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - When it comes to a quote, the reference to the source should be given in the text itself, in parentheses with the following: the author's last name, the year of publication of the used source and the serial number of the page. If the quoted text in the paper is longer than four lines, it should be separated as a separate paragraph and written in font size: 10, indented 1.5 cm in relation to the main text. - In the list of used literature at the end of the work, do not put ordinal numbers in front of the references. - Book: The reference should contain the surname and initials of the author, the year of publication, the title of the book (in italics), the place of publication and the publisher. - Journal article: The reference should contain the surnames of all authors with initials, year of publication in parentheses, title of the article, full name of the journal (in italics), volume (year), number, pages. - Web document: The reference should contain the name of the author, the year, the name of the document (in italics), the date the site was visited, and the Internet address.
